The Galaxy Trust believes that the core skills of reading, spelling and number should be practised as part of any learning taking place at home.

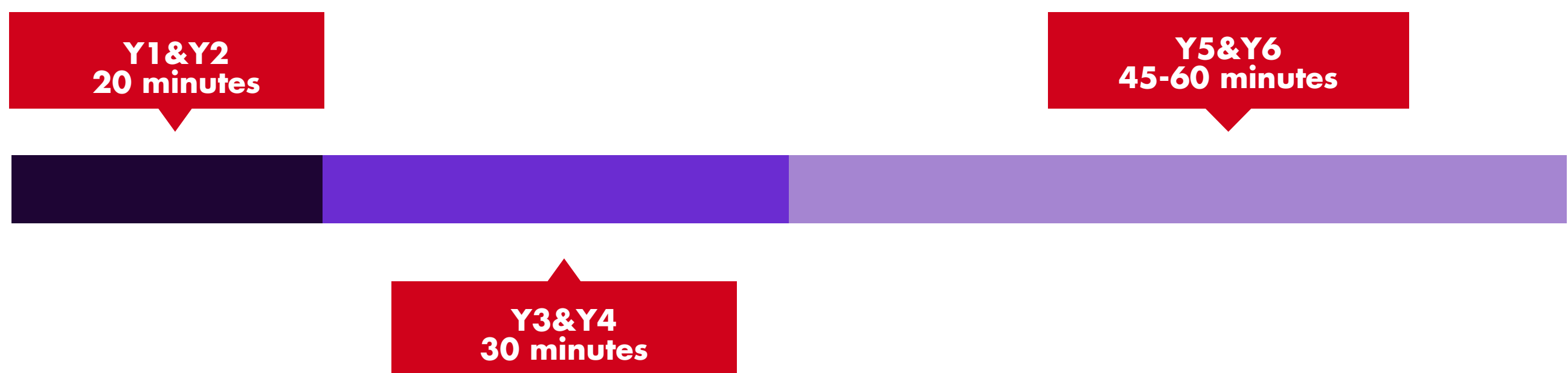

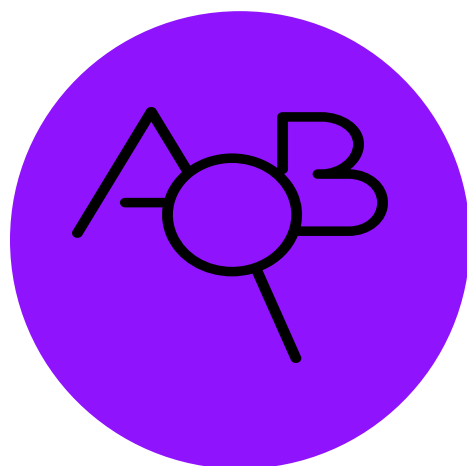

## How much time should pupils spend on homework each night?



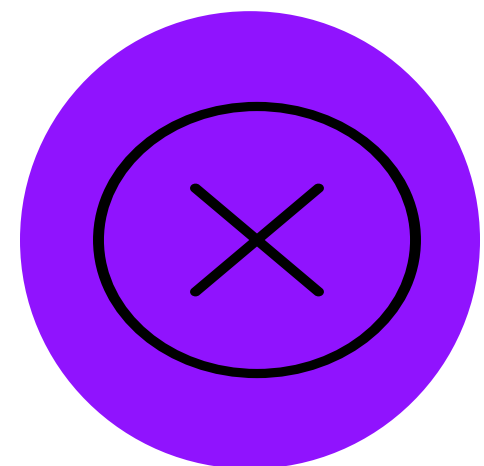
### Reading

## Learning-based tasks

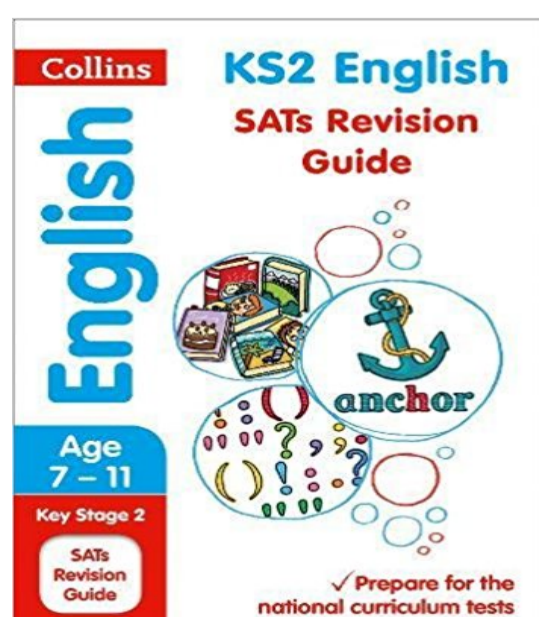
