Welcome to Term 3! We hope that you find this overview useful to help you support your child in accessing their learning this term. Our topic this term is **Heroes and Heroines**; we will be exploring a variety of texts, including 'There's a Superhero in your book', 'Superworm', 'Supertato', 'Megaboy' and non-fiction texts about insects and modes of transport. This term will see the start of our Phonics sets. Children have been grouped based on their assessment last term and their sessions will be targeted appropriately.

We will also be continuing our Parent Reading mornings every Friday. You are welcome to come in to school with your child from 8:30-8:45am every Friday to read with them in their classroom. We look forward to seeing you then,

Here are some activities you can do at home:

- Design your own superhero costume either by drawing or making.
- Go on a minibeast hunt and draw what you find. Perhaps you could explore the Enchanted Woodland
- Try a fruit or vegetable you haven't eaten before and rate it out of 5!
- Draw your own healthy meal on a paper plate and then cook it (with adult supervision)
- Re-watch the RWI phonics videos to recap sounds learnt last term
- Practise counting forwards and backwards from 0-10
- Practise drawing the numbers using the TenTown rhymes
- See how many number bonds you can find to make 10
- Play 'ping pong' finding doubles to 10.
- Take a trip to Temple Hill or Dartford Libraries. It is free to register!
- Make some crafts to develop scissor skills
- Practise writing your name, including your surname using lots of different media - maybe using paint or in shaving foam!
- Login to your Numbots account and gain a few more stars and earn coins!
- Go on a mode of transport you haven't been on before or plan a trip to include how you would get there.
