Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This week, we are learning about what makes a superhero.

At home

Encourage your child to be a superhero by helping out around the house, being kind to friends and family, etc. Perhaps they could say one thing before going to bed they have done to be a superhero.

Communication and Language

In our book this week, the Scribbler draws different things in the book.

At home

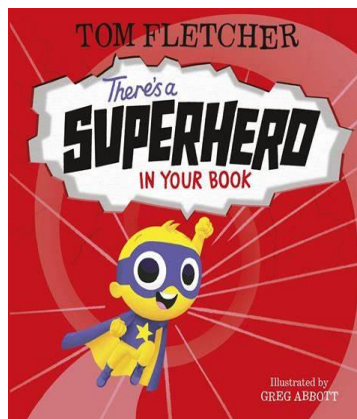
Discuss what the Scribbler has drawn and why. Were the things helpful or not? Discuss with children what superhero powers they would choose and why.

Physical Development

Superheroes can run, jump and fly in order to rescue people or objects.

At home

Can you create your own superhero obstacle course to test your coordination and agility? Can you use some positional language to explain how to complete your course? Share a video to Dojo!



English

There's a Superhero in your book is a lovely interactive book we will be reading this week. We will be discussing different superpowers found in the books as well as creating some of our own.

At home

Encourage your child to draw their own superhero and write some of the initial sounds their Superhero name. What superpower does it have? Does it have a special costume to wear? If you can, write a simple sentence telling us about your superhero.

Maths

This week we are learning about odd and even numbers and doubles. We will be looking at numbers to find out whether they are odd or even and be able to explain how they know. We will also be using manipulatives to make doubles and understand what a double or near double is.

At home

Discuss with your child whether a number is odd or even. Ask them to explain how they know. Play a game of dominoes and find the doubles within the set. Can they recall doubles of numbers to 5?

At home you may want to...

- Get creative and create your own junk modelling superhero or design a superhero's outfit
- Practise the high frequency words and tricky words posted on Dojo.
- Login to Numbots and try and earn some coins and stars.
