At home

At home

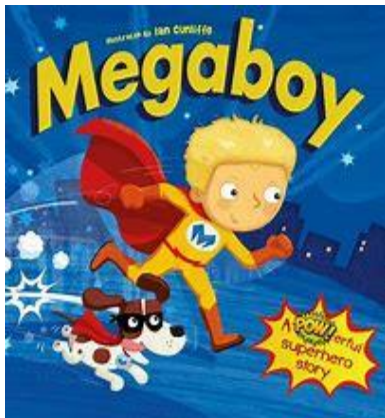
Can you talk about who your sidekick might be? Would they be another person or an animal? What would their superpower be?

Physical Development

How do superheroes move? What superpowers do you know?

At home

Can you try to move like different superheroes? What is your favourite superpower, super speed, super jumps, super skipping? Post a video on Dojo of you showing your super power!



English

This week, our book is about Megaboy. It is another superhero-themed story and the last one of our term's work on Heroes and Heroines. Next week we are switching to non-fiction once again! We are learning about questions and sequencing the story in the correct order.

At home

Read one of your favourite stories and then try and retell it in the correct sequence. Perhaps you could make up some questions to ask your favourite superhero.

Maths

This week we are learning to represent 10 before finding ways to make 10 in three ways, i.e. $4 + 4 + 2$. At the end of the week, we will be finding and making doubles.

At home

Can your child tell you different ways to make 10 using two or three numbers? Can they make it using objects in your home? Develop a rapid recall of known double facts to 5. How quickly can they say them? Can they spot any doubles in real life?
