## We are learning to...

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This week, we are learning about different jobs in Careers Week. We are looking forward to a visit from the police and firefighters to listen to the work they have to do.

#### At home

Talk to your child about your job. What do you do? Is it something you have always wanted to do? Share your experiences. Talk to children about why people have jobs and compare the types of jobs now and in the past.

### Communication and Language

We will be discussing lots of jobs and linking this to people who help us. We will be reading a variety of non-fiction texts about different careers.

#### At home

Ask your child if there is a job they would like to do when they are older. Why? Are there any jobs that they would not like to do?

### Physical Development

Many jobs have a physical aspect to them requiring strength and great gross motor skills, others may require more fine motor control.

#### At home

Can you build your strength, like a builder, and help carrying shopping bags or your book bag? Maybe practise your fine motor control by writing a list or note.



### English

This week, we are going to be reading a variety of non-fiction texts about different jobs. We will be considering what qualities you need to carry out certain jobs, for example, a bus driver meets lots of people every day, so should be kind and friendly, a vet needs to like working with animals, etc.

#### At home

Think about how many different people with different jobs you come across in one day. Make a list of all them. Which one would you like to do for a day?

### Maths

This week we are revisiting our work on patterns and specifically repeating patterns. We will be trying to recognise the different shape patterns as well as manipulating shapes and fitting them into tangrams. Children will be learning to rotate and move shapes so that they fit into a given outline.

#### At home

Can you spot any repeating patterns in your home or on the way to school? What shapes are they? What is the pattern? Using some cut up shapes, make your own shape picture by rotating and moving the shapes around.

### Word Aware

These are the words we are learning this week taken from our Here to Help Us range of books.

Can you explain what they mean to an adult?
