The Galaxy Trust values are Respect, Responsibility and Equality and this applies to all of our schools and the provision we offer to the children who attend them.

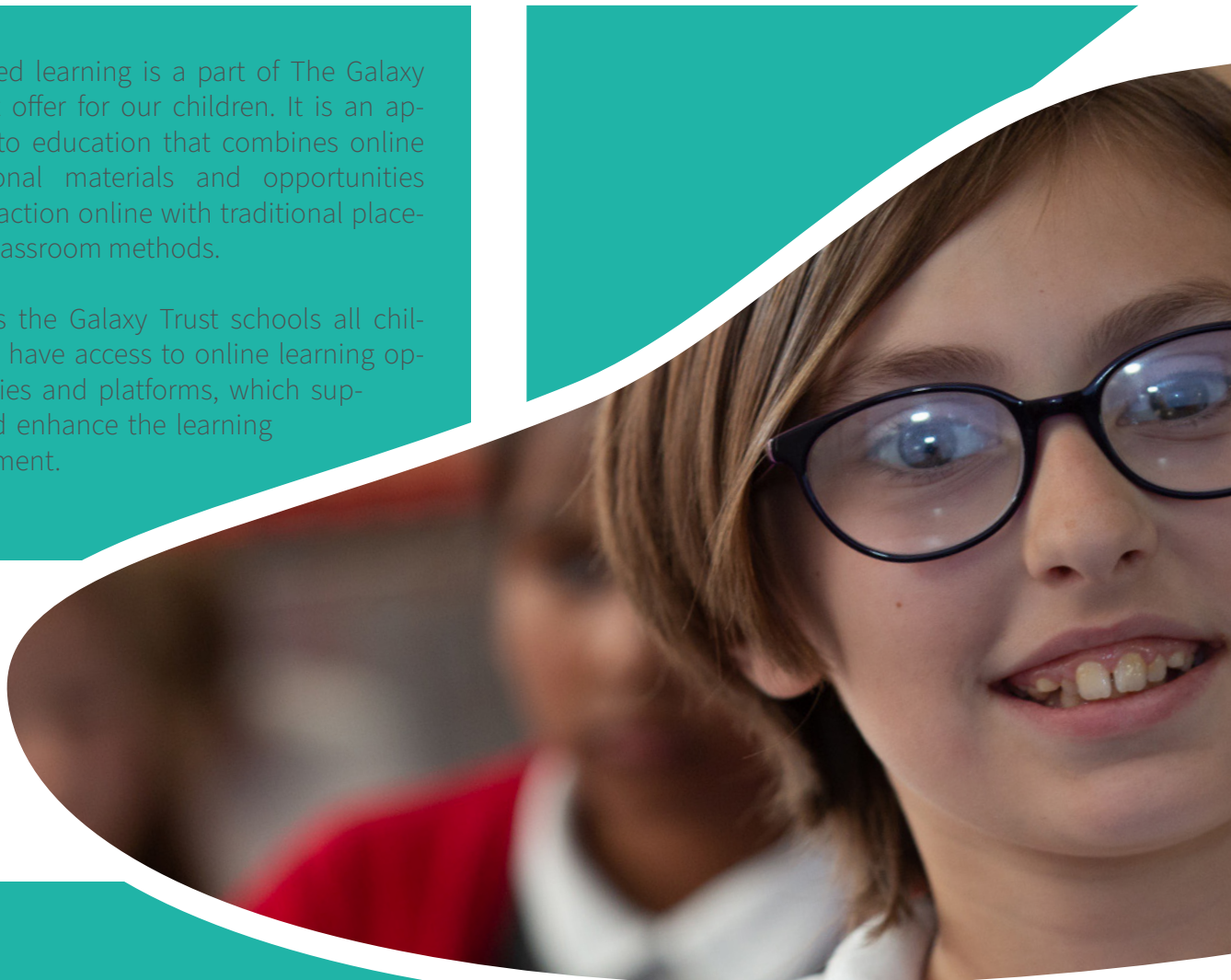
Our mission for each setting, is for our leaders to create and develop their own curriculum in each school with a wide range of extra curricular activities.

Class Dojo

ClassDojo is used across the Trust Schools to connect teachers with our students and families. The platform's communication focuses on delivery through whole school and class group pages. Photos and videos from the school can be shared and messaging can be translated into more than 35 languages. It also enables teachers to note feedback on students' skills and creates a portfolio, so that families can be aware of school activities outside of meeting with teachers.

Mathletics

Mathletics offers access at an individual level, as well as collectively as a school. Children have access to math quizzes, challenges and can participate in real-time networked competitions, known as 'Live Mathletics'. Teachers can tailor the quizzes and challenges to the curriculum being taught in the classroom to give a holistic and informed approach to home learning.

Accelerated reader

Accelerated Reader helps children at school manage their reading and provides Galaxy Trust teachers with assessment of pupils reading ability. AR encourages reading and gives children access to comprehension quizzes once a text has been completed. AR can also help improve children's knowledge on many different varieties of books and also raise their vocabulary.

TT Rock stars/Pixl Timetables Apps

Times Tables Rock Stars and Pixl Timetables are programmes of daily times tables practice aimed at children across our schools. The programme boosts childrens times tables recall speed.
