### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This week, we are learning about road safety and people who can help us.

#### At home

At home, practise crossing roads safely if walking to and from school. Encourage your child to choose a safe place to cross. Talk to your child about who safe adults are and how they can help.

### Communication and Language

Sharing and being kind to your friends is so important. Rainbow Fish is going to show us what happens when we are kind and share.

#### At home

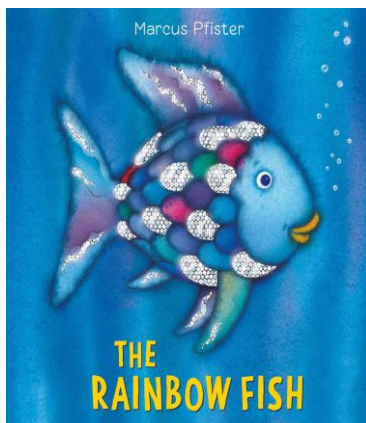
Discuss what sharing is and what we need to do to share. What do we say when someone shares with us?

### Physical Development

Rainbow Fish loves to swim around showing off his beautiful scales. He makes his muscles strong by swimming to and fro.

#### At home

At home, can you create a water environment using a tub of water and some pasta or stones as fish? Encourage your child to pick the fish out of the water.



### English

Rainbow Fish is so beautiful and colourful. This week are using our vocabulary to describe the flashing scales and shimmering lights. We are thinking about under the sea and the different creatures that live there. Can you draw a picture and use your sounds to write a description?

#### At home

At home, your child could draw an underwater creature. Encourage them to use their phonics to describe their picture. How could you write this?

### Maths

We are learning about the properties of shapes, including circles and triangles. We will be looking for them in our environment and creating our own shape pictures.

#### At home

Go on a shape hunt and find circles and triangles in the local area. Can you spot any on the way to or from school? Do you have any circles or triangles in your home? Where are they? Create a list or take photographs and share on your child's portfolio.
