At home

Can you discuss what makes a villain? What do they behave like? How would you describe them? Should you behave like a villain?

Communication and Language

At home

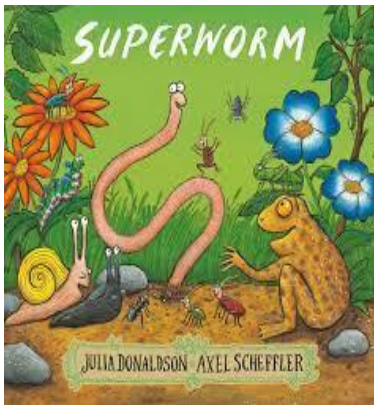
Talk to children about different insect names and what sounds they begin with. See if you can find some outside and discuss their habitat. Describe them to each other using adjectives.

Physical Development

Animals and insects move in lots of different ways, e.g. worms slither, frogs jump, ladybirds fly and ants scuttle.

At home

Can you try to move like different animals and insects? What is your favourite movement? Can you upload some videos to your Dojo profile to share with the class?



English

This week, Superworm is about an amazing word who can save other minibeasts and animals. But he then needs their help when a wicked Wizard Lizard captures him!

At home

You could look for minibeasts in your garden or visit the woodlands. Can you identify them? How many legs do they have? Can they fly? You could draw and have a go at labelling the different things you find.

Maths

This week we are learning about the numbers 9 and 10, representing them in different ways. We have continued our work on subitising to 5 and want to apply this knowledge when working with larger numbers spotting patterns and groups of smaller numbers; to help with our counting. We will be using a range of manipulatives and tens frames.

At home

Can your child show you different ways to represent 9 or 10. How many different ways can they find? Use 10 of any objects. Take a photo and upload to Dojo to share with the class.

At home you may want to...
