This week, we are discussing villains and learning to describe them. This week's villain is the Evil Pea!

At home

Can you discuss what makes a villain? What do they behave like? How would you describe them? Should you behave like a villain?

Communication and Language

In Supertato, the Evil Pea traps all the fruit and vegetables.

At home

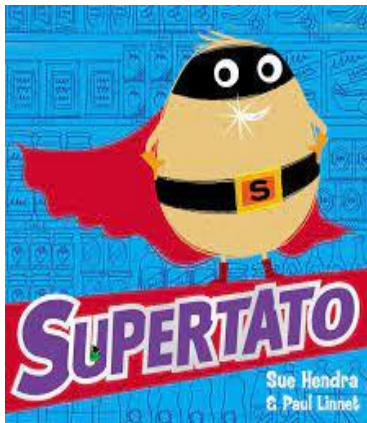
Can you describe the difference between fruits and vegetables? Introduce different fruits and vegetables to the children's diet. Maybe try a new fruit or vegetable you haven't eaten before.

Physical Development

How do superheroes move? What superpowers do you know?

At home

Can you try to move like different superheroes? What is your favourite superpower, super speed, super jumps, super skipping? Post a video on Dojo of you showing your super power!



English

This week, our book is called Supertato, who rescues all the vegetables that have been trapped by the Evil Pea. We will be focusing on describing the characters introducing adjectives and revisiting retelling of the story.

At home

You could discuss healthy eating and what a balanced diet is. Talk about having five pieces of fruit a day and what a healthy plate looks like. Describe your favourite fruits and vegetables using adjectives or choose your favourite book character and describe them.

Maths

This week we are learning one more and one less using larger numbers. We will also be using the part, part whole model to show the composition of numbers, for example, 6 can be made from 4 and 2 or 5 and 1, etc.

At home

Can your child discuss different ways to make a number? How many different ways can they find? How could this be represented? How would this be written as a number sentence?

Give your child a number and ask them to tell you what is one more or one less.

Word Aware

These are the words we are learning this week taken from our text, Supertato:

evil, frozen, escaped, conveyor belt, distress, crimes, vanished, search and cornered.
