At home

At home

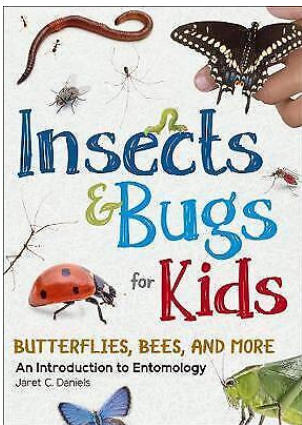
Talk to your child about how to care for animals both outside and within your home. What are they called? What do they eat?

At home

Can you try to move like different insects? Can you make an obstacle course to manoeuvre? Share a video on Dojo of your insect movements and we can try and guess what they are!



English

This week, we are using a variety of non-fiction texts about insects and bugs. We will be looking at the different features and comparing fiction and non-fiction texts. We will be locating the contents page and introducing the index and glossary. We are also practising using our sounds to write simple sentences when creating a shared fact file about an insect.

At home

Create your own fact file about your favourite insect or animal. Use your sounds to write the letters you can hear. Draw a picture of a bug and label it.

Maths

This week we are learning about 2D and 3D shapes. We will be looking at the different properties and names of shapes and finding them in our environment. We will also be looking to see what 2D shapes we can spot within 3D shapes.

At home

Can you go on a shape hunt and find as many 2D and 3D shapes as you can? Tell your adult what they are called and share the number of faces, edges and vertices (3D) or sides and corners (2D).
