At home

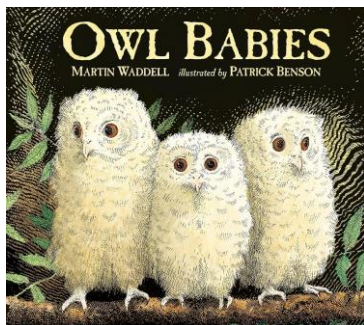
Can your child create their own questions about a book you are reading?

We are learning about exercise today and how it changes our heartbeat.

At home

Hold your own Olympics and investigate which exercises speed up your heartbeat the most.



English

This week, we are reading Owl Babies. We will make predictions about the story before we start reading. We will then be learning to sequence a story, using key events to summarise the plot and explain what happens.

At home

Before reading a bedtime story, ask your child to make a prediction about the story using the front cover and title to help them. After reading it, see if they can summarise and sequence key events from the story.

Maths

This week we are learning about numbers 11-20. We are ordering and sequencing numbers up to 20. We will also continue to learn about place value and how to build 2-digit numbers.

At home

Can you count forwards to 20 and backwards from 20? Can you demonstrate your understanding of place value by building numbers using tens and ones?

Can you order numbers 0-20 correctly?
