## We are learning to...

### PSED

We will be thinking about ways we can look after our environment. We will be learning how to reduce, reuse and recycle.

#### At home

Talk to your child about these words and look at packaging together. Discuss whether it can be recycled or not. Could it be re-used for something? Bring it in and add to our junk modelling box.

### Communication and Language

Thursday is Spanish Day and we will be learning basic greetings and numbers to 10.

We will also be using a map to locate Spain.

#### At home

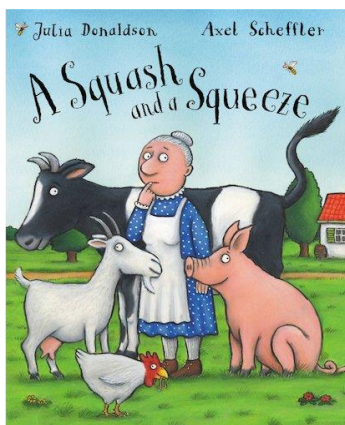
Ask your child what they have learnt. Can they say hello and goodbye and recite numbers to 10 in Spanish?

### Physical Development

The children are currently practising for Sports Day.

#### At home

Practise balancing a pair of socks on your head and walking around your home without them falling off. Create a mini obstacle course and practise completing it. Practise jumping over an item as if it was a small hurdle.



### English

This week, we are reading another of Julia Donaldson's books, A Squash and a Squeeze. We will be re-enacting the story and retelling it through written word. We will also revisit our work from last week on rhyme as this book is also written in rhyme.

#### At home

Can your child retell the story to you? What characters were in the book? Do you have a favourite story at home that you can retell? Perhaps you could build your own story map.

### Maths

This week we are ordering numbers to 20 as well as finding different ways to make 5 and 10. We will finish the week using the part-whole model to add two or more numbers together.

#### At home

Can you draw your own part-whole model and find different ways to make a certain number? Perhaps use a dice to roll two numbers and add them together making your own number sentences.

Practise your number formation ensuring that each number to 20 is written correctly.

### Word Aware

These are the words we are learning this week taken from A Squash and a Squeeze

Can you explain what they mean to an adult?
