Encourage them to use adjectives when describing.

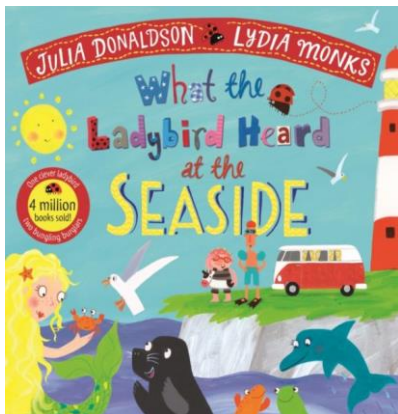
Physical Development

English

This week, we are reading 'What the Ladybird heard at the seaside' and using this text to describe a beach scene. We will be revisiting adjectives and trying to use them in our writing, as well as retelling the story at the end of the week.

At home

Describe the seaside - what might you see, smell, hear, taste or touch. What would it be like? If you have been to the seaside, write about what you did there. If you haven't been, maybe imagine what it would be like to go there and write or draw what you would do.

Maths

This week we are consolidating our work on doubles and recalling number facts to 5 and 10 as quickly as we can. We will be using manipulatives, 5 and 10s frames to support our learning. We will also be thinking about different ways we can compose these numbers using more than two parts.

At home

Practise your number bonds to 5 and 10 and your rapid recall of doubles. Play the 'Ping Pong' game where one says ping and the other pong. Instead of pong one time, say a number and your child has to say the other number that makes the number bond.
